#### State Enrollment

- Decrease in enrollment (9,800 students) in total Public K-12 Enrollment in the 2017-18 school year enrolling approximately 6,211,000 students.
- A decline of 258,000 in total enrollment is projected, if current trends in fertility and migration hold, resulting in total enrollment of 5,953,000 by 2027-28.
- ♦ 55% of the state's k-12 districts are in declining enrollment


Three Main Reasons:




