Dual Enrollment - Dr. Issaic Gates

Traditionally, Dual Enrollment Programs offer high school students the opportunity to earn college credit while taking the same classes needed to meet their high school's requirements for graduation.

- Academic Maturity Increased Interest learning, relevancy for students, academic maturity
- Academic Maturity Students begin to explore degree majors by taking courses in their area of academic interest
- Save money Traditionally, student do not pay tuition or fees for dual enrollment courses
- Save time Because dual enrollment student starts college earlier, they are more likely to start graduate degrees during the traditional 4-year bachelor's degree program.
- Increased Admission Rate Dual enrollment of Potential for articulated transfer pathways to colleges and universities
