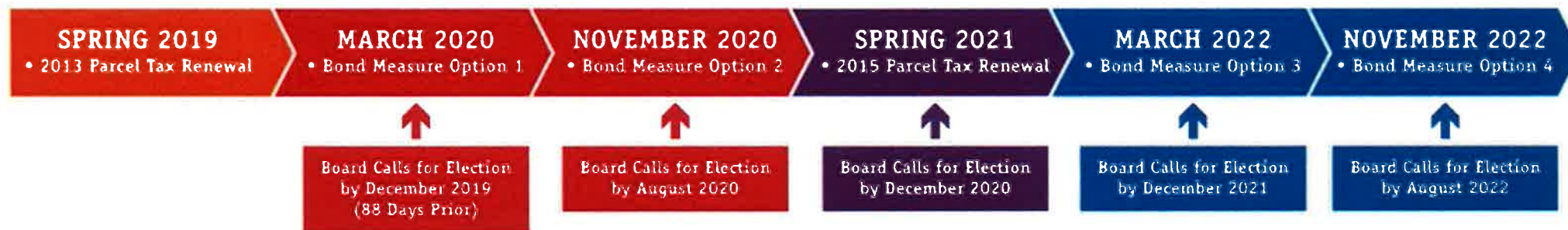

# Election Sequence Options For Bonds and Parcel Taxes



\*Board must call for an election 88 days prior. Deadlines subject to change based on LA County Registrar of Voters

- Parcel taxes should be renewed before they expire
  - Measure R was renewed by voters in February 2019
  - Measure E Parcel Tax shown with early Spring 2021 election
- The Prop 39 G.O. Bond Election can take place in:
  - March 2020 Presidential Primary Election
  - November 2020 Presidential General Election
  - March 2022 Gubernatorial Primary Election (Potential, June 2022 would be primary election)
  - November 2022 Gubernatorial General Election

# Bond Election Timing Options

	<b>Now – Nov. 2019:</b> Build Consensus	<b>Now – July:</b> Build Consensus
	<b>October. 2019:</b> First Reading <b>November. 2019:</b> Second Reading <b>By Dec. 6th:</b> Board Calls for Election	<b>May 2020:</b> First Reading <b>June 2020:</b> Second Reading <b>By July 2020:</b> Board Calls for Election
	<b>Nov. 2019 – Mar. 2020:</b> Independent Advocacy Campaign	<b>Aug. – Nov. 2020:</b> Independent Advocacy Campaign

## Considerations:

- March is the Presidential Primary and is expected to see turnout similar to November 2018
- SB 268, if signed by the Governor, will apply to the March election
- November will be the Presidential General and include at least 2 tax initiatives, one of which is to roll back Proposition 13 for businesses
- November will be a longer ballot – so getting a message heard in November maybe difficult
