It is recommended that the Board of Education adopt Resolution No. 9 in support of the City of San Marino's Public Safety Tax.

Background

On June 28, 2019, the San Marino City Council adopted Resolution R-19-21, calling for a renewal election of the City's public safety tax for paramedic services, fire protection and prevention, and police protection to be held on November 5, 2019. The term of special tax would from 2020-21 through 2024-25.

The District values the public safety, police and fire paramedic services that the City provides to its schools and the San Marino community. The fire and police services provided by the City of San Marino are vital to our students, teachers, staff, parents and community members' safety and health.

It is recommended that the Board of Education adopt Resolution No. 9 in support of the City's renewal of its public safety tax election on November 5, 2019.

RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION OF THE SAN MARINO UNIFIED SCHOOL DISTRICT SUPPORTING THE CITY OF SAN MARINO, CALIFORNIA AND ITS EFFORTS TO SEEK RENEWAL OF THE PUBLIC SAFETY TAX FOR PARAMEDIC SERVICES, FIRE PROTECTION AND PREVENTION, AND POLICE PROTECTION

WHEREAS, the City of San Marino's Public Safety Tax helps ensure our schools' safety and protect San Marino Unified School District property; and,

WHEREAS, the San Marino Unified School District relies on the City of San Marino to provide paramedic services, police protection and fire services for its schools, employees and its students; and,

WHEREAS, the City of San Marino seeks to renew an expiring public safety tax beginning July 1, 2020, for a period of four years, on each parcel located within the City of San Marino; and

WHEREAS, if the Public Safety Tax is not approved, it could result in drastic cuts in police and fire safety personnel and equipment which would result in longer response times, potentially placing San Marino students at greater risk; and,

WHEREAS, the passage of this measure will continue the high-quality services provided to our students and schools by the City of San Marino's public safety professionals;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT: On behalf of the students and families of San Marino, the Board of Education of the San Marino Unified School District supports the City of San Marino's effort to continue a special Public Safety Tax for paramedic services, fire protection and prevention and police protection.
