WHEREAS, on March 10, 2020, the Board of Education of the San Marino Unified School District adopted Resolution #15 – Resolution of Intention to Terminate Certificated Employees Due to a Reduction of Particular Services Effective July 1, 2020 (“Resolution #15”) (attached hereto as **Exhibit “A”**), which authorized and directed the Superintendent or his designee to initiate and pursue procedures necessary to layoff certificated teachers pursuant to California Education Code sections 44949, 44955 and other applicable provisions of law because of a reduction and/or discontinuance of particular kinds of service; and

WHEREAS, on or before March 15, 2020, the Superintendent or his designee duly and properly served notice on seventeen certificated employees, which stated that the Board intended to eliminate his/her position for the 2020-21 school year as a result of the reduction of particular kinds of service; and

WHEREAS, the each of the seventeen certificated employees were informed of his/her right to request a hearing, and each of the seventeen employees did request a hearing; and

WHEREAS, on or before April 21, 2020, each of the seventeen employees notified the District that he/she had withdrawn his/her request for hearing; and

WHEREAS, a hearing in this matter was set to take place before the Office of Administrative Hearings on April 22, 2020 in OAH Case No. 2020030764 (the “Hearing”); and

WHEREAS, on April 21, 2020, the District and each Respondent in the Hearing entered into a Joint Stipulation by which each Respondent withdrew his/her request for hearing and agreed that the following five employees shall be issued a final layoff notice by May 15, 2020:

1. Kristopher Good (0.4 FTE only)
2. Zainab Mamdani (0.8 FTE only)
3. Serafina Palazzolo
4. Katherine Simpson
5. Jessica VanderBaan

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that there is sufficient cause for not reemploying the five certificated employees listed above, and that such layoff relates to the welfare of the schools of the San Marino Unified School District and the pupils thereof; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the Board hereby approves the layoffs of the five certificated employees listed above, and directs the Superintendent or his designee to serve final notice to each of these certificated employees that his/her services will be reduced or eliminated (as indicated above) for the 2020-21 school year.
