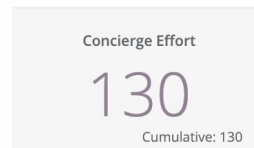
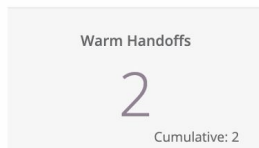

Care Solace

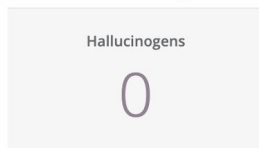
- **An online resource with a live 24/7 concierge line meant to assist individuals in finding local mental health related programs and services.**

- Care Solace takes into account all types of private insurance including Medi-Cal, Medicaid, and Medicare and those that have no insurance.
- The system also filters by age, gender, zip code and special request.

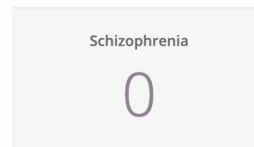
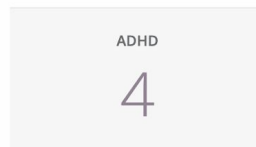
Mental Health KPI Update



Searches By Substance Use Disorders

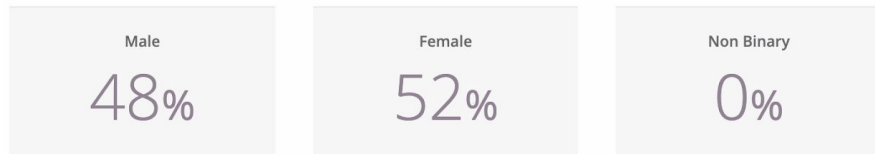


Searches By Mental Health

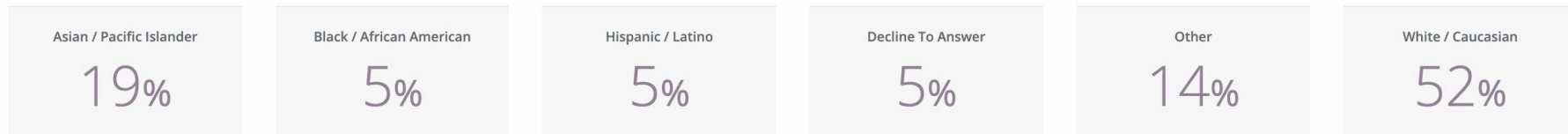
