

Representative And Deliberative Groups

01 The Governing Board believes that broad input on District operations and policy from
02 staff, parents/guardians, students and members of the public can provide the District
03 with a diversity of viewpoints and expertise, help build a sense of ownership of the
04 schools, enhance District efficiency and assist District communications. As desired,
05 the Superintendent or designee may establish a management team, administrative
06 councils, task forces, cabinets or committees in accordance with law.

07

08 The membership, composition and responsibilities of these groups shall be defined by
09 the Superintendent or designee. The Superintendent or designee may establish,
10 change or dissolve these groups at his/her discretion.

11

12 Groups established by the Superintendent or designee shall act in an advisory
13 capacity unless specifically authorized to act on behalf of the Superintendent or
14 designee. Advisory groups shall submit their recommendations to the Superintendent
15 or designee, who may report the recommendations to the Board as appropriate.

16

17 Expenses incurred for consulting services, materials, travel or other related operations
18 shall be approved by the Superintendent or designee in advance.
