14 determining the purposes for which funds may be used to meet the changing
15 needs of the District and its students. The Board recognizes that an
16 educational foundation is a separate legal entity, independent of the District.
17 However, the foundation is encouraged to provide regular reports to the Board
18 on the status of its work and to communicate ways that the District can help
19 support the foundation's activities.

24 With the consent of the Superintendent or designee, the educational
25 foundation, as appropriate, may use the District's name, a school's name, a
26 school team's name, or any logo attributable to a school or the District.
